



HOW HARP BEGAN


HARP Rescue was founded by Burke Bryant to address the urgent needs of those trapped in war zones, regions experiencing ethnic cleansing, and areas affected by disasters and terrorism. Recognizing a significant gap in the effectiveness of existing rescue efforts, Bryant combined his expertise with that of other military professionals to create a highly specialized response team dedicated to saving lives where others could not.





HIGH-RISK EXTRACTIONS


HARP specializes in rescuing individuals from remote and dangerous locations where others hesitate to venture. Since 2016, they have navigated some of the most challenging and dangerous terrains on Earth, including battlefields, natural disasters, cartel territories, terrorist strongholds, and underground trafficking tunnels.

HARP conducts extensive international open-source intelligence (OSINT) investigations and undercover operations to uncover human trafficking networks and their illicit activities. We collaborate closely with law enforcement and other state and federal agencies to apprehend human traffickers and dismantle their criminal networks, ensuring justice is served.






WHERE WE'VE SERVED







Nate Wilkins Vice President



Dr. Naval Parikh Head of Medicine


